

ECDA Takes the Stage at Women in Tech Summit 2025

On June 4–5, ECDA took the stage at the Perspektywy Women in Tech Summit, Europe's largest tech event for women. Victoria Cummings shared ECDA's mission to close the talent gap and promote inclusion in semiconductors—highlighting the need for stronger education-industry partnerships and support for underrepresented groups. With 220+ attending the session, it was a powerful moment to spotlight why inclusion isn't optional; it's essential.
